



Abstract Submission and Poster Presentation Guidelines

Abstracts

1. Abstract Length

- Language of abstract should be English
- The maximum abstract length is 200–250 words
- Include up to 6 keywords immediately after the abstract.

2. Content

- The abstract should clearly present the objective, methodology, significant findings, and conclusions of the work.
- Preference will be given to abstracts demonstrating novelty, scientific merit, and relevance to the conference themes.

3. Submission Format

- Submit the abstract as a single-page document in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx)
- The document should not exceed one A4 page.
- Abstract shall be prepared as per the template available for download at ESTIC 2026 website

4. Title and Author Information

- The title should be concise and not exceed 20 words.
- Clearly mention the names of all authors, their institutional affiliations, and indicate the corresponding author with an email address.

5. Conference Theme Selection

ESTIC 2026 has 12 thematic areas.

6. Abstract Evaluation

- All submitted abstracts will undergo a screening process based on their scientific quality, originality, novelty, and relevance to the selected conference theme.
- The decision of the Abstract Review Committee shall be final and binding.

7. Communication of Results

- Only authors of shortlisted abstracts will be contacted through email.
- Detailed guidelines for poster preparation and presentation will be shared with the shortlisted participants.

8. Institutional Approval

- Authors are solely responsible for obtaining all necessary permissions, institutional approvals, or clearances required for submission and presentation of their work.

9. Important Note

- Submission of an abstract does not constitute an invitation to participate in ESTIC 2026.
- Selection for poster presentation will be based solely on the evaluation of the submitted abstract.

10. Time lines

- Abstract submission opening: 10 Aug 2026
- Last date of Abstract submission: 30 Aug 20206
- Intimation to shortlisted candidates for poster presentation along with poster guidelines: 20 Sept 2026
